

The Database of the European Community Studies Association-Canada (ECSCA-C) features the profiles of active ECSCA-C members. It is embedded within the larger Europe Canada Network ([EUCAnet.org](http://EUCAnet.org)) expert database and hosted at the Centre for Global Studies (University of Victoria). The database connects ECSCA-C scholars with many multidisciplinary expert groups working on European Union, European Integration and issues of Eu-ropean affairs often from a comparative perspective.

Currently, the **ECSCA-C database** includes over 100 scholars from across Canada, Europe, and the United States. The [comprehensive search functions](#) allow finding the experts by name, discipline, field of expertise, academic institution, city, and country.
